

Ear defenders disengaging when installed.



1. Engaging the ear defender clip – this position looks like it is engaged



2. From the side, it also looks engaged. Clip top is flush (red dashed line) to the top of the helmet mounted euro clip



3. However, turning the ear defender, the clip works its way out of the helmet mounted euro clip.



4. From the rear, the ear defender has fully worked itself out of position by rotating the ear defender more.



5. Engaging the ear defender clip – this position is engaged – the ear defender clip completely hides the helmet mounted clip. You can see more of the square slot on the helmet (indicated)



6. From the rear, you can see the ear defender clip now sits higher than the helmet mounted euro clip. Compare to image #2



7. On rotation, the ear defender clip does not disengage or work its way out of the helmet mounted euro clip.

Note:

When engaging the ear defender clip, it is important to push the ear defender clip until it 'clicks' into position within the helmet mounted euro clip.

To check if this has happened if you don't hear an audible 'click', turn the helmet to view from the rear (as shown in image #6) and check to see if the ear defender clip is sitting above the helmet mounted euro clip.
